### A Special Blessing!

Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ or Nazareth our savior. In this lesson we will talk about a special blessing that God has ordained for those who obey him. This is a blessing of provision that most have overlooked. Consequently, they don't receive. Let us explore.

Now, we are command to appear three times a year before the Lord. This is at a place that is designated by his ministers (**Deuteronomy 16:16**). These are not regular assemblies. They are generally called the feasts of the Lord (See Leviticus 23). They are the Passover season, the feast of weeks of Pentecost and the Feast of Tabernacles. When God gives you an assignment, there will be provision since we shall not appear empty!

Further more, we are told to give an offering as we are blessed (**Deuteronomy 16:17**). God does not expect us to give from nothing, so, He blesses us and then we individually determine the amount of our offering. Here is an implied blessing that most neglect or ignore! Get hold of it.

So, what is the method of these provision. In **Deuteronomy 14:22**, we read of a tithe that the thither shall consume. This is not the tithe for the general fund or the work of ministry. This is for the God-fearing person to consume along with their families etc. Please read **verses 23-27**. Here we are told to change the produce into money if that is not the case and carry it to your destination. Then buy the products or food that is needed. This we do as we rejoice before the Lord because of all these blessings!

This will be a world-wide observation when Jesus returns and establish the kingdom of God on earth (**Zachariah 14:16**). Most of the world is not involved now. That will change when Christ returns. The rebellious ones will not get rain (**verse 17**).

God issues a test in **Malachi 3:10-11** for any person willing to prove the validity of this blessing. God would not give us an impossible mission. In fact, the world, those outside the church, will clearly see that God is with us because of his provisions. Notice **verse 12**. we will be a delight in the eyes of the observer. As children of God, we are a light to the world. We wear a "type" of badge representing Jesus and the kingdom of God. Our life is a living testimony of God's goodness. Ask your pastor or your source of this literature, for more information and the location of the next feast assembly. Coming before God as he commands not only pleases our savior, is a great blessing to you as we rejoice before our God. Get hold of this blessing!!
